People are encouraged to park in the Cathedral grounds and town car parks and walk to Ballyglass. Please leave the parking places near the cemetery free for the elderly and infirm.

Parking will be available in St Finian's College grounds.

- ◇ Traffic coming from the town direction will enter the college grounds by the Irishtown gate
- ◇ traffic coming from the old Longford road will enter by the main gate opposite the cemetery.

Please arrive early to avoid delays.

Gardai and Civil Defence volunteers will be on hand to assist with traffic flow and parking, as well as to ensure safety for all. Please comply with their instructions.

The collection taken at the cemetery gates is to defray amplification costs. *(cost €1,400 in 2014)*
