The month of November is an occasion for us to continue the tradition of visiting the church and cemetery to pray quietly for our dead. Remembering our loved ones, family and friends during the month of November has always been seen as an act of charity to the faithful departed from those who still have the gift of life to help them attain their eternal rest. Our prayers, particularly the offering of Mass, expresses our hope that God will free the person who has died from any burden of sin and prepare a place for them in heaven.

'From the beginning the Church has honoured the memory of the dead and offered prayers in suffrage for them, above all in the Eucharistic sacrifice, so that, thus purified, they may attain the beatific vision of God.' (Catechism of the Catholic Church n. 1032)

If you would like to add the names of those who have died to the Altar List of the Dead to be included in Masses in Mullingar Parish throughout the month of November and every First Friday, please complete an Altar List of the Dead and return it to the Cathedral.

November Practices:

Visiting a cemetery. Making a pilgrimage to a cemetery to pray for those who are interred there is a beautiful tradition.

Pray Offer up daily prayers for the Holy Souls. Make a sacrifice for this intention by making a fast (sweets, alcohol, smoking, social media etc)

Comfort the Bereaved Pray for those who have been bereaved throughout the year, and if they would appreciate a visit, do so.

Abstain from Alcohol, take a month's pledge to the Sacred Heart.

Understand (Re)Discover the Church's teaching about death by reading the Catechism of the Catholic Church, Article 11 "I believe in the resurrection of the body".



MOVEMBER



"Movember" is a movement to support men's physical and mental health, bringing attention to these issues by growing facial hair and raising money for charity throughout November. It could also be a chance for men to grow spiritually by making time for prayer each day, undertaking a fast and sharing the gospel with others, while being reminded by St Augustine: "The beard signifies the courageous".
