40 Hours Eucharistic Adoration for the Protection of Life

"The thief comes only to steal and kill and destroy; I have come that they may have life and have it to the full. John 10:10

Meath Diocesan Eucharistic Adoration Committee with the blessing and support of Bishop Michael Smith and the priests, are organising 40 Hours of Eucharistic Adoration for the retention of the 8th Amendment. Following the recent Supreme Court ruling, the 8th Amendment is the only remaining protection for the unborn. Eucharistic Adoration will take place in 7 locations across the diocese including St Paul's Church, Mullingar. It will commence at 6pm on Friday 13th April with celebration of Mass, ending Sunday 15th April with Mass at 10.30am in St Paul's.

Please note that during the 40 hour Adoration in St Paul's Church, Adoration in the Cathedral will be suspended.

Choose life "The child in the womb has life and potential. However, like all babies, before birth or in the early years, she or he has no choice. Powerless to defend themselves they rely on the rest of us to protect their lives and vindicate their rights. By using the word 'choice' we need to remember that, for the baby waiting to be born, the choice we make can be a matter of life or death." Irish Bishops

We also pray for all the volunteers who are working so hard to educate members of the public on the consequences of changing the 8th Amendment. All Parishioners are invited to take part at any time during the 40 hours. We need commitment from at least 60 Adorers for our allotted time. Time allocated to Mullingar Parish is from 11 pm on Saturday night to 10 am Sunday morning.


