## World Meeting of Families & Visit of Pope Francis



Over 500,000 tickets have been booked for the Final Mass of WMOF2018, which will be celebrated by Pope Francis at 3pm on Sunday 26th August, in the Phoenix Park. All tickets have now been reserved and booking has closed for this event. Within a week of tickets being released to the public, 400,000 tickets for the Closing Mass in Dublin's Phoenix Park were booked and the Pastoral Congress in the RDS is now also fully booked, with a record-breaking 37,000 registrations.

The first bus organized by the parish to the Phoenix Park on the 26th August is now full. If you have booked a place on the bus and still not paid your fare, please do so in the coming days.

Due to demand we hope to provide an additional bus. If you have already reserved a ticket online for the Papal Mass and are interested in booking a seat to the Phoenix Park on Sunday 26th August, please contact Fiona at the Parish Office during this week.
