Tomorrow is the final day to register your child for First Communion and First Confession in 2018 if your child attends a non-Catholic school. There has been a big increase in the number of parents who want their children to receive the sacraments and we are trying to facilitate as many as possible. The classes begin next month and there will be about 20 classes in total before First Communion is received and 15 before First Confession.
