The idea of this new team was launched, appropriately, on Mission Sunday. It is our hope that the team will help our parish to become more missionary, as Pope Francis encourages us. The team will work on practical, useful gestures and initiatives to better celebrate and share our faith, as well as to become more welcoming and imaginative in our outreach to others. A commissioning ceremony will take place on our parish Feast Day of Christ the King next Sunday at 11am Mass.

The members of the team will serve for a three-year period only, ending in November 2021. Training will be provided and guidance from the Irish Bishops Conference will be followed in terms of roles and responsibilities.

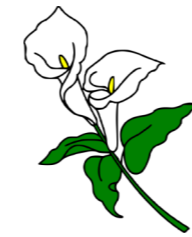
What next?

Next weekend will be the closing date for adding names to the parish List of the Dead. You are encouraged to include on your list the names of people whom others may have forgotten.

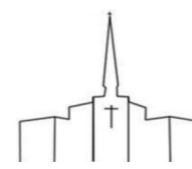
