Confirmation Enrolment 2020 Sunday 9th June

Children in 5th class are invited to enrol for Confirmation on Pentecost Sunday (9th June). Enrolment forms will be distributed to our Catholic schools in the coming weeks. *We ask the children from Presentation Senior School, St Mary's primary school, Gaelscoil an Mhuilinn and St Brigid's school to attend the 11am Mass in the Cathedral, the children from Holy Family (Curraghmore) and St Colman's school to attend the 10.30am Mass in St Paul's Church, children from St. Colmcille's school, Gainstown to attend the 11am in Gainstown Church and the children from St Kenny's school to attend the 10am Mass in Brotenstown church.* If your child attends a non Catholic school (*Educate Together, All Saints or Gaelscoil an Choilín*) and you would like them to receive Confirmation next year, they must enrol on this day also and attend the 11am Mass in the Cathedral. The enrolment form will be available to download from the parish facebook page or from the parish office. Please wear something red on the day to represent the Holy Spirit.

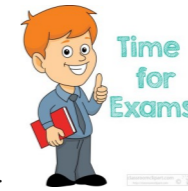


Fleadh Mass of Thanksgiving
