Commemoration of All Souls - 2nd November

"Remember those O Lord, who in your peace have died, yet may not gain love's high reward till love is purified" This day is set aside to pray for the souls of the Faithful Departed, who in purgatory await that final call into God's presence in heaven. You are encouraged to visit the graves of loved ones, do a good turn on behalf of the deceased and meet to pray for those who have died.

A Plenary Indulgence can be received for the Holy Souls this day, fulfilling the usual conditions of Sacramental Confession, Reception of Holy Communion and Praying for the Holy Father's Intentions.



An indulgence for the Holy Souls can also be received during the first week of November in devoutly visiting a cemetery and praying for those interred there.
