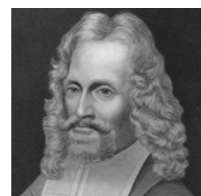

St Oliver Plunkett's Day



St Oliver Plunkett, a native of our diocese, was born on 1st Nov, 1625 at Lough Crew, near Oldcastle, Co. Meath and martyred on the 1st Jul, 1681 at Tybrun near what is now Hyde Park in London. St Oliver was consecrated Archbishop of Armagh in 1669 in the Cathedral of Ghent, Belgium and

returned to Ireland, after his education and work in Rome, in the aftermath of the Cromwellian conquest of Ireland where the public practice of the Catholic Faith was banned and clergy threatened with exile or execution. It is reported that St Oliver confirmed over 48,000 people over a 4 year period!

St Oliver was arrested and found guilty of High Treason for "promoting the Roman Faith", and was hung, drawn and quartered at Tyburn; the last Catholic martyr to die in England. He was canonised in Rome in 1975, and was entrusted with the patronage of Peace and Reconciliation in Ireland, as well as our own Hurling Club in town. With the tensions of Brexit overshadowing so much of our peoples these days, may St Oliver Plunkett intercede for all involved in these delicate political negotiations for the good of all on these islands.

The annual Mass and Commemoration of St Oliver Plunkett takes places in Lough Crew, Co. Meath today (June 30th) at 3pm, celebrated by Bishop Smith and homilist Fr Kevin Heery. Lough Crew is about 35mins away, via Collinstown.

Blessing for expectant parents will take place after the 6pm Mass in the Cathedral next Saturday 6th July.

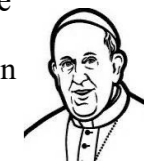
